**MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT:** Central Illinois Public Service Company (AmerenCIPS) and Union Electric Company (AmerenUE)

Request for approval of revisions to delivery services tariffs, and for approval of Delivery Services Implementation Plan for Residential Customers.

**STATUS:** Following exceptions and replies, a post exceptions proposed order (“PEPO”) was distributed under a cover memorandum dated October 25. The matter was before the Commission for consideration at the bench session on November 7 and the Commission meeting on November 27.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Entry of the previously distributed PEPO.

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In this proceeding, Ameren proposes revisions to its delivery services tariffs. Among other things, delivery services would be made available to residential customers. Pursuant to 16-104(a)(4) of the Act, such services must be offered before May 1, 2002. Under 16-108(b), an order must be entered at least 30 days before the date on which the delivery services must commence. Under 16-105, the implementation plan is to be approved at least 60 days prior to the commencement date. In its filing, Ameren also seeks approval of proposed Rider SG which is intended to apply to the provision of standby delivery service to self-generation customers.

As noted above, this matter was on the agendas for the bench session on November 7 and the Commission meeting on November 27. The previously distributed PEPO is not attached to this memorandum.
