**RECOMMENDATION:** Dismiss Petition by Yellow Sheet Order.

This matter concerns a Petition filed by LaTessa Salone and others for an emergency rulemaking concerning the policies of The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company regarding termination of service for non-payment. The Petition was filed just after the increased gas prices for the winter of 1990 created the possibility that many residences would be terminated due to non-payment. However, on August 31, 2001, the parties entered into a Settlement Agreement, which fully and finally addressed the concerns expressed in the petition. Subsequent to execution of the Settlement Agreement, the Petitioners filed a Notice for Withdrawal and Request for Dismissal of their Petition.

It is clear that the Petitioners have fully settled their dispute with the Respondent. Accordingly, we recommend that the Commission dismiss this Docket by Yellow Sheet Order.
