1           JUDGE HAYES: Pursuant to the direction of the  
2 Illinois Commerce Commission, I now call Docket  
3 No. 02-0009. One Link Communications, Inc.,  
4 application for certificate of interexchange  
5 authority to operate as a reseller of  
6 telecommunications services in the State of  
7 Illinois.

8           May I have your name and address for the  
9 record, please.

10           THE WITNESS: My name is J.P. Pannell. P as  
11 in Peter, a-n-n-e-l-l, with One Link Communications,  
12 Inc., at 8400 North University Drive, Suite 204 in  
13 Tamarac, T-a-m-a-r-a-c, Florida 33321.

14           JUDGE HAYES: And are you going to be  
15 testifying today?

16           THE WITNESS: Yes.

17           JUDGE HAYES: Please raise your right hand.

18                           (Witness sworn.)

19           JUDGE HAYNES: I just have a few questions  
20 today.

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1                   J.P. PANNELL,  
2           called as a witness herein, having been first duly  
3           sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

4                   EXAMINATION

5                   BY

6                   JUDGE HAYES:

7           Q.     What is your title at One Link?

8           A.     I am the regulatory administrator and the  
9           interim secretary of One Link.

10          Q.     And are you only looking for interexchange  
11          authority or local authority as well?

12          A.     Only interexchange.

13          Q.     And what services do you intend to provide in  
14          Illinois?

15          A.     We are going to provide one plus services.

16          Q.     And who do you plan to market your services to?

17          A.     Basically for the most part residential  
18          customers.  Later on maybe in 2003 we are planning  
19          to start marketing to businesses.

20          Q.     And what state is the company incorporated?

21          A.     Delaware.

22          Q.     And is One Link Communications authorized to do

1 business in Illinois?

2 A. Yes, ma'am.

3 Q. Does One Link Communications provide  
4 telecommunication services at the present time?

5 A. Well, no, we do not right now, we are a start  
6 up company, and we -- our president  
7 Mr. Martinez has years of experience in the  
8 telecommunications industry. We are licensed in  
9 several states and we are -- our legislative  
10 approvals are just about starting to come in, so we  
11 should be able to begin selling in hopefully 15 days  
12 or so.

13 Q. What other states are you certified in?

14 A. We are certified in Florida and -- excuse me,  
15 let me grab the list real quick. We are authorized  
16 in Virginia, Texas, Florida, New Jersey, Michigan,  
17 Iowa, and the District of Columbia, and Colorado,  
18 currently.

19 Q. And who are the stockholders and officers?

20 A. Mr. Martinez is the sole officer and  
21 stockholder.

22 Q. Does he have an interest, ownership or

1 otherwise in any other entity that provides  
2 telecommunications services?

3 A. No, ma'am.

4 Q. Does the company intend to offer operator  
5 assisted services?

6 A. Only directory assistance.

7 Q. Which underlying carrier will One Link be  
8 relying on to provide its services?

9 A. Qwest Communication.

10 Q. In which state do you plan on keeping your  
11 books?

12 A. In Florida.

13 Q. Do you agree to pay for the expense of  
14 Commission staff doing an audit which might include  
15 staff traveling to Florida?

16 A. Yes, ma'am.

17 Q. If necessary. Do you understand that you must  
18 file rates and tariffs with the Commission prior to  
19 offering services?

20 A. Yes, ma'am.

21 Q. Have any complaints been filed against the  
22 company with regard to slamming or cramming?

1 A. No.

2 Q. What internal procedures does One Link have to  
3 guard against slamming and cramming?

4 A. Well, we -- all of our sales will be verified  
5 through a third party verification service and  
6 recorded. We monitor those recordings diligently to  
7 make sure that we are in compliance with the  
8 slamming and cramming laws in the different states.  
9 And so we have that recorded verification.

10 Q. What is the date on your financial statements?

11 A. Well, right now we have a pro forma financial  
12 statement that shows projected earnings for its  
13 first year.

14 Q. Okay.

15 A. We are a year end corporation, and we will, you  
16 know, we will be glad to provide additional  
17 financial statements as we, you know, after the  
18 first quarter of selling, or however the Commission  
19 would like.

20 JUDGE HAYES: I think this is fine for now. I  
21 don't have any further questions. Is there anything  
22 you would like to add?

1 THE WITNESS: No, ma'am not that I can think  
2 of.
