PETITION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to 83 Ill. Admin. Code § 200.200, Illinois Power Company ("IPC") hereby petitions the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") to be permitted to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of its Petition, IPC states:

1. IPC is a combination gas and electric utility regulated by the Commission, having its principal offices at 500 South 27th Street, Decatur, Illinois 62521.
2. MidAmerican Energy Company, Nicor Energy, L.L.C., AES New Energy, Inc., and the National Energy Marketers Association initiated this Docket for the purpose of seeking an expedited rulemaking which would permit retail electric suppliers to enroll customers by telephonic and internet enrollment procedures.
3. IPC, as a gas and electric utility, may be affected by the decision of the Commission in this docket, and its interests are not adequately represented by any other party to

this proceeding. Therefore, IPC wishes to participate in the proceeding and present its position on the issues raised by the parties.

4. IPC requests the following be added to the service list in this proceeding:


