SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES (SEWER)

16.00 SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT CONNECTION FEE

16.01 Where connection is requested by any Customer, or by any Developer of a subdivision, to Company sewer mains that are tributary to and serviced by treatment plants owned by the Company, the charges, conditions and requirements of this rule shall apply.

16.02 Definitions - For purposes of this rule, the following definitions shall apply:

- a) "Average Annual Treatment Revenue" means the difference between the Collection Service rate and the Collection and Treatment Service rate set forth in Section 13 of this Schedule for the applicable class of Customer, multiplied by monthly estimated usage, if applicable; multiplied by 12 months.
- b) The "Average Project Unit Cost" means the average cost per PE of constructing recent new and proposed sewage treatment facilities and/or capacity additions within the Company's service area. The current average project unit cost is \$658.00 per PE. The average project unit cost may be adjusted by the Company from time to time when the average construction costs change, pursuant to the Commission's procedures for the revision of this Schedule.
- c) "Connection Fee" means: (Average Project Unit Cost times Number of PE) less Average Annual Treatment Revenue for the applicable class of Customer. The Connection Fee shall be grossed up for the amount required to pay applicable federal and state income taxes, unless the Customer or Developer elects to waive refunds under Rule 16.05, using the no-refund procedure set forth in Rule 16.06.
- d) "Deposit Agreement" means a contract to be executed by the Company and a Developer under the circumstances set forth in Rule 16.04 and shall contain the specific terms of the deposit calculations and identify the designated sewage treatment facilities that will treat wastewater from the development, estimated project costs, refund provisions and other applicable terms of the deposit.
