**NARRATIVE STATEMENT
FOR MODIFICATION OF EXISTING ENHANCED 9-1-1 SYSTEM**

The Christian County Emergency Telephone System Board respectfully requests an amendment to our existing 911 service plan. Currently, Christian County provides for enhanced 911 services for all of the customers in the telephone exchange (217) 768 –Moweaqua. There are sections of this exchange in southern Macon County.

Upon approval and activation of enhanced 911 services in Macon County expected in the 3rd quarter of 2002, we request the implementation of the following amendment to the Christian County system plan:

1. Christian County will continue to provide enhanced 911 service for Macon County residents with Telephone exchange of (768 – Moweaqua).

Call handling agreements shall remain in effect for the Moweaqua exchange.

A map of this area may be obtained from the Macon County 9-1-1 Administrative offices.

All other existing terms and conditions of the Christian County Enhanced 9-1-1 System Plan remain in effect.
