**RECOMMENDATION:** Enter the attached Order dismissing Complaint, with prejudice

This matter concerns a Complaint filed by AccuTel of Texas, Inc., ("AccuTel") alleging that when Ameritech required a \$2 million deposit prior to processing any AccuTel orders, Ameritech violated several provisions in Section 13-514 of the Act. AccuTel's Complaint was filed pursuant to Section 13-514 and 13-515; therefore, there are short statutory deadlines attached to this matter.

The parties have executed a full and final settlement agreement regarding the dispute that forms the basis of this Complaint. It is clear that the AccuTel has fully settled its dispute with Ameritech. Accordingly, I recommend that the Commission enter the attached order dismissing this Docket, with prejudice.
