1 JUDGE HILLIARD: On behalf of the Illinois
2 Commerce Commission, I call Docket 02-0551, Flossie
3 Falls versus Commonwealth Edison.

4 Ms. Falls, could you state your name and
5 address for the record, please.

6 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: My name is Flossie Maye
7 Falls. My address is 5742 South Union.

8 JUDGE HILLIARD: Okay. And on behalf of the
9 company?

10 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: On behalf of Commonwealth
11 Edison Company, Felicia Franco-Feinberg, Exelon
12 Services, 10 South Dearborn, Floor 35, Chicago,
13 Illinois 60603.

14 JUDGE HILLIARD: Okay. Pursuant to a
15 discussion we've had off the record, the parties
16 have agreed to a discovery schedule; and any
17 discovery that either party has should be submitted
18 in writing on or before Thursday, October 31st,
19 should be received by October 31. I'll make it sent
20 by October 31.

21 And responses are going to be due
22 November 21st, and we will have another status date,

1 which you can anticipate in by telephone, ma'am, if
2 you want to.

3 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: What?

4 JUDGE HILLIARD: If you don't want to come in,
5 we'll call you again.

6 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: When?

7 JUDGE HILLIARD: On December 4th at 11:00.

8 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Okay. If I'm working, can
9 it be later?

10 JUDGE HILLIARD: If you're working, let me
11 know. We'll schedule another time.

12 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Okay. Because you can get
13 me after work.

14 JUDGE HILLIARD: That's fine. Okay?

15 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Okay.

16 JUDGE HILLIARD: Ms. Franco-Feinberg is going
17 to let you know what her address is; so if you have
18 something to send the company, you'll know where to
19 send it. Okay?

20 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: All right. She's going to
21 give me the address?

22 JUDGE HILLIARD: Yeah.

1 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: And is the address going to
2 come along with the --

3 JUDGE HILLIARD: No. She'll give you the
4 address before that. Have you got a pencil there
5 now.

6 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Yeah, I have one in my
7 hand.

8 JUDGE HILLIARD: Maybe she'll just give it to
9 you now.

10 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: Okay. It's Felicia
11 Franco-Feinberg. Do you need me to spell that,
12 Ms. Falls?

13 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Yes, I do.

14 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: Both the first and last
15 name or just the last name?

16 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Your first name. What's
17 your first name?

18 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: It's Felicia. That's F,
19 as in Frank, e-l-i-c-i-a.

20 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Uh-huh.

21 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: The last name is Franco,
22 F-r-a-n-c-o, hyphen, Feinberg, F-e-i-n-b-e-r-g.

1 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: F-e-i-n what?

2 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: B, as in boy, e-r-g.

3 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Oh, Feinberg. Okay.

4 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: My address you need to
5 put Exelon.

6 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: F-1?

7 JUDGE HILLIARD: Exelon, E-x-e-l-o-n.

8 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: E-x.

9 JUDGE HILLIARD: E-l-o-n.

10 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Oh, okay.

11 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: Business services.

12 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Say that again.

13 JUDGE HILLIARD: Business services.

14 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Okay. Business services.

15 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: 10 South Dearborn.

16 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: 10 South Dearborn.

17 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: Floor 35.

18 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: 435?

19 JUDGE HILLIARD: Floor 35.

20 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: 435.

21 JUDGE HILLIARD: No, floor like --

22 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Oh, the floor.

1 JUDGE HILLIARD: Right.

2 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: 35th Floor?

3 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: Yes. Chicago, Illinois.

4 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Beg your pardon?

5 JUDGE HILLIARD: Chicago.

6 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: Okay.

7 MS. FRANCO-FEINBERG: Illinois 60603.

8 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: 0603.

9 JUDGE HILLIARD: Right.

10 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: That's it?

11 JUDGE HILLIARD: 60603.

12 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: 60603?

13 JUDGE HILLIARD: Right. Okay?

14 MS. FLOSSIE FALLS: All right.

15 JUDGE HILLIARD: I'll talk to you in December
16 then. Thank you.
