**REQUEST TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR JULIE TO RESPOND TO  
THE ILLINOIS ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY ENGINEERS'  
REQUEST FOR DECLARATORY RULING UNTIL JANUARY 14, 2003**

Intervenor/Respondent, J.U.L.I.E., INC. ("JULIE") by its attorneys Spesia, Ayers & Ardaugh requests that the time frame for JULIE to file a response to the Illinois Association of County Engineers ("IACE") Request for Declaratory Ruling be extended until January 14, 2003. In support thereof, JULIE states as follows:

1. The IACE recently filed a Request for Declaratory Ruling with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("ICC") seeking a declaration that counties and townships should not be required to participate in the State-Wide One-Call Notice System encompassed within the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

2. On December 9, 2002 JULIE filed a petition to intervene and a Request for Additional Time to respond to the Request for Declaratory Ruling filed by the IACE. Prior to JULIE filing its Request for Additional Time, Responses to the IACE's Request for Declaratory Ruling were to be filed by December 24, 2002. JULIE's Request for Additional Time only sought an extension to file a Response until December 30, 2002 (6 additional days).

3. Due to the holiday season, many of JULIE's Board Members and Staff are on vacation and/or unavailable. These individuals need to be consulted prior to JULIE filing its Response. Therefore, it is requested that the time in which JULIE has to respond to the IACE's Request for Declaratory Ruling be extended until January 14, 2003. At the time the original extension of time was filed, attorneys for JULIE did not know that various JULIE Board Members and Staff were unavailable.

WHEREFORE, J.U.L.I.E., INC. requests that the ICC extend the time frame in which it may respond to the IACE's Request for Declaratory Ruling until January 14, 2003.




