This matter concerns Commission approval of the First Amendment to a Negotiated Agreement between Illinois Bell Telephone Company (SBC Illinois) and Franklin Square Communications, Inc. No Petitions for Leave to Intervene were filed and there were no contested issues in this docket. The First Amendment to the Agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the Agreement and implementation of the Amendment to the Agreement would not be contrary to the public interest, convenience and necessity.
