**SUBJECT:** Kenneth W. Fukar, d/b/a Few Car Enterprises

Petition for Withdrawal of Service Authority to Provide Customer-Owned Pay Telephone Service (COPTS) within the State of Illinois.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Grant Petition.

---

On March 28, 2003, Kenneth W. Fukar, d/b/a Few Car Enterprises ("Few Car") filed a verified Petition seeking cancellation of its Certificate of Service Authority to customer-owned pay telephone services ("COPTS"). The Commission issued Kenneth W. Fukar, d/b/a Few Car Enterprises a COPTS Certificate in 1989. Few Car ceased operations in January of 1990. Therefore, discontinuance of service by Kenneth W. Fukar, d/b/a Few Car Enterprises will not deprive Illinois customers of any necessary telecommunications services and is not otherwise contrary to the public interest.

Accordingly, I recommend that the Commission grant the Petition to cancel Few Car's Certificate of Service Authority to provide COPTS in Illinois.
