MOTION TO RESET SCHEDULE

South Austin Coalition Community Council (ASACCC@) by its attorney Allen W. Cherry, makes this motion to rest the schedule previously establish in this matter. In support of this motion SACCC states as follows:

1. This matter involves a complaint alleging that Commonwealth Edison Company (AEdison@) violated the Public Utilities Act by closing the Austin Bank Service Center.

2. According to the schedule set in this matter on April 15, 2003, (1) SACCC was to prefile its testimony May 27, (2) Edison was to prefile its testimony July 11, (3) SACCC was to prefile its rebuttal testimony August 1, (4) a pretrial memorandul was due August 15, and (5) a status hearing was set for July 22, 2003, at 1 p.m.

3. SACCC still has not filed its initial testimony and that testimony is late enough that efforts by SACCC and Edison could not

lead to this case proceeding according to the schedule originally set.

4. In terms of the reason for the late filing, the main problem has been that the project has simply taken much more time than originally contemplated. There have been specific problems as well including (1) SACCC=s attorney's new computer system failing and being replaced and (2) SACCC=s reduced staffing levels causing other deadlines and obligations to interfere with its work on the testimony.

5. SACCC regrets the delay and regrets any inconvenience this may have caused the Hearing Examiner or Edison.

6. SAccc cannot today commit to a specific date sooner than August 1, 2003, although it is likely all testimony will be filed in two weeks. SACCC is willing to participate in a status hearing at this point or after the testimony has been filed, either in person or by conference call.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays the Hearing Examiner reset, either now or at a future date, the schedule previously set in this matter and for such other relief as is just and equitable.

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
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
