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1 (Witness previously sworn.)

2 DOROTHY D. GUM

3 called as a witness herein, having been previously
4 sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

5 EXAMINATION

6 BY MR. BALOG:

7 Q. You're still under oath; and would you state
8 your name, please?

9 A. Dorothy D. Gum.

10 Q. Now, if I asked you the same questions that
11 I asked your husband, would your answers be the same?

12 A. Yes.

13 Q. Okay. During his deposition, you made faces
14 and you thought there was things that should be added
15 that he didn't necessarily go into.

16 Do you remember what those were?

17 A. One was just this, that -- this was a
18 receipted copy. One was just a copy, one was a
19 receipted copy, that we actually paid the bill for the
20 hookup. (Indicating.)

21 Q. Okay.

22 MR. GUM: Yeah. When you asked for a receipt, I
23 just said --

24 THE WITNESS: He said, no, we didn't have a

1 receipt and --

2 MR. GUM: She pointed out that --

3 BY THE WITNESS:

4 A. I don't have a copy of the check, but I have
5 a receipted copy here that they got my check.

6 BY MR. BALOG:

7 Q. Okay.

8 A. So I have proof that I did pay my service to
9 get hooked up, yes.

10 Q. Okay. During your husband's testimony, he
11 sort of indicated that you handled most of the dealings
12 with Com-Ed; is that true?

13 A. Uh-huh.

14 Q. Okay. Let's go back to the beginning.

15 Were you the one that requested
16 Com-Ed hookup at Davis Road?

17 A. Yes.

18 Q. And do you remember when that was?

19 A. Well, going by this, I was thinking it was
20 November but you have records of July, and that's
21 ringing a bell, that we would have started, yes, in
22 July, had delays; and so we called 'em back, said don't
23 come yet, and then they came later.

24 Q. Okay.

1 A. So they would have come in in November after
2 we paid.

3 Q. Okay. But the process all started in July?

4 A. It started in July. I mean, we had plans of
5 starting in July, didn't quite get it going and so it
6 was delayed as far as getting the actual hookup done,
7 yes.

8 Q. Okay. When the actual hookup came, did you
9 start getting bills?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. Okay. Now, in your family, do you handle
12 the checking account and --

13 A. I pay the bills.

14 Q. -- when the bills come in, you make all the
15 payments?

16 A. I pay the bills.

17 Q. Like most families I would assume.

18 A. Uh-huh.

19 Q. Okay. So when did you get the first bill
20 from Com-Ed?

21 A. Well, I would assume it would have been in
22 January. I don't honestly know because I don't have
23 the records; but after paying this one, I would say
24 they would have started coming in January, yes --

1 Q. Okay. And --

2 A. -- of '90.

3 Q. Do you recall what the amount of the bills
4 were or anything like that?

5 A. Have no idea.

6 Q. And how many bills did you receive from them
7 in 1990?

8 A. Well, I'm gonna say it was like three or
9 four, like he said.

10 Q. Okay.

11 A. And then they stopped coming.

12 Q. Okay.

13 A. I called and said where are they. I got
14 some again, a few more in '90, and then they stopped
15 again.

16 Q. Okay. And you were the one that
17 contacted --

18 A. Yes, I did.

19 Q. -- Com-Ed?

20 You contacted them the first time.
21 Did you contact them the second time when the bills
22 stopped?

23 A. Say that again.

24 Q. Okay. I'm sorry. I'll be more clear.

1 You indicated that you started
2 receiving the bills for the Davis property in January.

3 A. Yes.

4 Q. You got --

5 A. Several.

6 Q. -- let's say, three bills.

7 A. Yeah.

8 Q. You called up Com-Ed, and then the bills
9 started coming again; is that correct?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. Okay. How many bills did you receive after
12 you called them?

13 A. Honestly, I don't remember.

14 Q. Okay.

15 A. We would have got a few more in that same
16 year, in 1990.

17 Q. Okay. When they stopped again, did you
18 contact Commonwealth Edison?

19 A. Not at that time, no.

20 Q. Okay.

21 A. I kind of forgot.

22 Q. Okay. I'm not --

23 A. I know, I know.

24 Q. I'm not being judgmental. Okay?

1 A. I didn't get a bill. I just didn't think
2 about it.

3 Q. Okay. Did you contact Com-Ed at any time,
4 let's say, it's the middle of 1990 to the present?

5 A. Not after the initial time, no.

6 Q. Okay. So when the transformer went out,
7 your husband was the one that contacted them?

8 A. Yeah. The contact was by him at that time,
9 I guess.

10 Q. You didn't contact them for any reason
11 whatsoever during that period of time?

12 A. No, I did not.

13 Q. Did you receive any other bills during that
14 period of time, from approximately the middle of 1990
15 until 2002?

16 A. No, I did not.

17 Q. Do you remember when was the first bill you
18 received from them in 199 -- or 2002?

19 A. I'm going to say around March.

20 Q. And you paid the bills religiously since
21 that day?

22 A. Uh-huh, yep.

23 Q. Now, do you recall completing an application
24 for Commonwealth Edison at any time?

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1 A. I'm going to say yes. Do I have a copy?

2 No.

3 Q. Okay.

4 A. But I remember filling something out but ...

5 Q. Do you remember when that was?

6 A. It would have been in '89 before we started
7 construction.

8 Q. Okay. So you completed an application prior
9 to even getting those documents, which are Plaintiff's
10 Group Exhibit B? (Indicating.)

11 A. Uh-huh. To the best of my recollection, I'm
12 going to say, yes, I did.

13 Q. Okay. So you would have -- again, I'm
14 trying to just get things clear in my mind.

15 You conceivably could have been
16 getting a bill from this -- the Davis property and a
17 bill from the Wheeler property at the same time?

18 A. Correct.

19 Q. Okay. But because it's such a long time ago
20 there's no way of checking it?

21 A. No.

22 MR. BALOG: Okay. I have nothing further.

23 BY MR. PABIAN:

24 Q. Mrs. Gum, thanks for coming. Just a couple

1 of questions for clarification.

2 When you -- I think your husband
3 indicated -- and you indicated you agreed with him --
4 that you were paying for electricity directly when you
5 were living at the Wheeler property; is that correct?

6 A. Yes.

7 Q. Okay. When you were -- when you moved from
8 the Wheeler property, were you the one that contacted
9 Com-Ed to tell Com-Ed what to do with respect to your
10 electric service then? I mean, to stop it or to do
11 whatever?

12 A. To stop the service at the Wheeler property?

13 Q. Right.

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Okay. And do you recall what you told them?

16 A. I can guess what I would have said.

17 Q. Okay. I'll take that.

18 A. Okay. We were going to be moving out like
19 the middle of December -- I think it was around
20 December 20. I would have told them that we were no
21 longer going to be living there, to stop our service at
22 the Wheeler property; and that we would no longer be
23 paying the bill for that address, and we would only be
24 billed for the -- for up on Davis Road.

1 Q. Okay. Did you tell them who would be paying
2 the bills for the --

3 A. I don't recall if I told them.

4 Q. Did you -- I'm sorry. When did you move out
5 of the Wheeler property?

6 A. December of '89.

7 Q. December of '89.

8 And when did you move into the Davis
9 Road house?

10 A. March of '90.

11 Q. It was March of '90, okay.

12 And during that interim period, you
13 lived at your mother's house; right?

14 A. At my mother's house, correct.

15 Q. Do you -- while you were living at your
16 mother's house, did you get a final bill for service at
17 the Wheeler property?

18 A. Have no idea.

19 Q. Okay.

20 A. What would you mean by a final service?

21 Q. Well, I mean, you know, if you moved out on
22 a certain day --

23 A. Yeah.

24 Q. -- and you went some place else --

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1 A. You mean did it say "final notice" on there
2 to me? Like a big red flag or --

3 Q. No, no. I mean a bill up to -- for the
4 service up to the date you moved out.

5 A. I would assume so. I don't know.

6 Q. Okay. You don't know?

7 A. I don't know.

8 Q. Okay. So you don't know if while you were
9 living at your mother's house, a bill was sent to there
10 for the -- for electric service up to the day you moved
11 out of the Wheeler property?

12 A. Say that again.

13 Q. Okay. You don't recall whether while you
14 were living at your mother's house a bill was sent to
15 you there by Com-Ed to charge for the service up to the
16 date you moved out of the Wheeler property?

17 A. That it would have been mailed to the
18 Wheeler Road property?

19 Q. I just want to find out if you knew where
20 the bill was mailed or did you tell Com-Ed where to
21 mail the bill?

22 A. Okay. I would say -- I would have told them
23 that I was not going to be living there anymore, not to
24 mail it to me to that address and to mail it to the new

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1 one, and then they were holding that for us down at the
2 post office --

3 Q. Oh, okay.

4 A. -- until we got our box put up.

5 Q. Okay. To the Davis Road property?

6 A. Correct.

7 Q. Okay.

8 A. So I would assume that's where they would
9 have mailed it.

10 Q. Okay. When did you start -- do you recall
11 when you started picking up mail for the Davis Road
12 property?

13 A. At the post office or out at our box?

14 Q. Either. When you first -- the very first
15 time you started picking up mail for the Davis Road
16 property, about when was it and where were you living
17 at the time?

18 A. Well, in December when I would have moved
19 out, at that time I would have had to pick up anything
20 at the post office in Big Rock prior to getting our
21 mailbox put up.

22 Q. Okay. But what I'm trying to find out is
23 when did mail start coming to you addressed to the
24 Davis Road property?

1 A. Well, it would have been the beginning of --
2 I don't know when the mailbox got put up, to be honest
3 with you, so ...

4 Q. No. I'm not saying when it got put in the
5 box or when it got left at the post office.

6 I'm just trying to figure out when
7 you started using the address of the Davis Road
8 property to receive mail.

9 A. December of '89.

10 Q. Okay. Before the --

11 A. When I moved out.

12 Q. Okay. Before that time you were having
13 everything sent to the Wheeler Road address?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Okay. Did you ever have anything sent to
16 you at the address -- at your mother's house?

17 A. No.

18 Q. Okay. Because you knew that was going to be
19 short term --

20 A. Yes.

21 Q. -- so why start changing and change again?

22 A. Right.

23 Q. Okay. Did you hear the list of names that I
24 read to your husband?

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1 A. Yes.

2 Q. Did any of those names ring a bell?

3 A. A few.

4 Q. The same ones that rang a bell for your
5 husband?

6 A. The very same ones, yes.

7 Q. Were there any others that didn't ring a
8 bell for him that rang a bell for you?

9 A. No.

10 Q. Okay. Save some time. That's good.

11 For those that -- names that you
12 recognized, did you have any dealings with them other
13 than acquaintance-type dealings, any dealings with
14 respect to the property or the house or anything like
15 that?

16 A. No, I didn't.

17 Q. Okay. Just one other question.

18 I think your husband had indicated
19 that the property on which your house is located now
20 was -- the lot itself was bought from your
21 mother-in-law; is that correct?

22 A. Correct.

23 Q. Okay. And that previously that was part of
24 a larger farm or a larger tract; is that correct?

1 A. Correct.

2 Q. And that was -- the larger property was at
3 one time owned by I think a partnership between your
4 husband's uncle and his mother; is that correct?

5 A. Correct.

6 Q. Okay. And that eventually it all came to
7 your uncle somehow; is that correct? I mean, your
8 husband's uncle, your husband's uncle, your uncle-in-
9 law; is that right? Your husband's uncle came to own
10 it all; is that correct?

11 A. Except the one acre.

12 Q. Except for the one acre on which your
13 house is, that's correct.

14 A. Correct.

15 Q. Does he still own that property?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. Okay. And is it being used for agricultural
18 purposes?

19 A. His?

20 Q. Yes.

21 A. His property?

22 Q. Yes.

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. Okay. So would it be correct -- would I be

1 correct in saying that no part of that property ever
2 was or is now in the possession of Cottonwood
3 Farm?

4 A. No, it was not.

5 Q. And, no, it is not; right?

6 A. And, no, it is not.

7 MR. PABIAN: Okay. I think that's all the
8 questions I have. Thank you very much.

9 MR. BALOG: Just another couple.

10 BY MR. BALOG:

11 Q. The person that signed the original letter
12 was Jerry Suhr, S-U-H-R.

13 Did you ever meet him?

14 A. No, I did not.

15 Q. Did you ever talk to him?

16 A. I do not recall.

17 Q. Okay. Do you remember the specific name of
18 anyone you talked to at Commonwealth Edison?

19 A. No, I do not.

20 MR. BALOG: Okay. Nothing further.

21 Again, you have the right to see your
22 deposition or you can waive your signature.

23 THE WITNESS: I'll waive my signature.

24 MR. BALOG: Okay. Great. Thanks for coming.

2 concluded.)
