

## School lunches improved, but still provide inadequate nutrition, auditors say

By Emily Gersema Associated Press Writer WASHINGTON (AP) — School lunches are more healthful than a decade ago, but many schools still fall short of feeding children meals with the right amount of nutrients and not too much fat, congressional auditors said Friday.

"While most schools have reduced the average percent of calories from fat in school lunches, few have met the required goal for fat content," the General Accounting Office said in a report commis- sioned by Sens. Tom Harkin, D-Iowa, and Richard Lugar, R-Ind.

No more than 30 percent of the total calories in lunches should come from fat, according to the Agriculture Department, which oversees the national school lunch program.

Of the 22 elementary and high schools reviewed nationwide, three-fourths were serving meals contain- ing 34 percent fat, according to the audit of lunches served during the 1998-99 school year.

Although the fat content remains high, it's an improvement over

1991-92 when school meals had 40 percent fat, said the GAO, the investigative arm of Congress.

Schools managed to low- estered levels, though. Eten school meals had 68 milligrams cholesterol, a 19 percent drop from 1992 levels. High school meals had 75 milligrams, a 21 percent drop from 1992.

The school lunch program has been under scrutiny by lawmakers because of concerns about obesity. The government estimates that 15 percent of children are obese and the problem is growing.

Activists say the lunches should blame for putting pounds on children, but the Agriculture Department defends the program, which feeds 27 million children every school day.

Many of the 22 schools reviewed said they have trouble limiting students' access to junk food drinks, partly because of limited budgets. Some schools rely on revenue from school-based machines sales, the profit from which they split with man- agers.
