
Spark Energy, L.P. (Spark Energy) reports to its customers, fuel sources and emissions data provided by PJM Interconnection (PJM), the local regional transmission organization, on a semi-annual basis. This allows our customers to see our sources of power and compare that against other retail electric suppliers servicing the region. Spark Energy does not provide power from any particular generating facilities; rather, the PJM residual power purchased by Spark Energy consists of electricity from a variety of power plants that PJM then transmits throughout the region as needed to meet the requirements of all customers in the PJM territory. Electricity generation is the process of generating electric energy from other forms of energy. Although electricity is a clean and relatively safe form of energy to use, there are environmental impacts associated with the production and transmission of electricity.

This product mix is subject to change and is updated on a quarterly basis.
