


## PUBLIC AWARENESS NOTICE TO NATURAL GAS CUSTOMERS

The gas piping on the outlet side of the gas meter belongs to the natural gas customer. MCPU does not maintain the customer's piping. Customer owned pipe could be buried steel, plastic or piping exposed to atmospheric conditions (above ground). If piping, whether buried or atmospheric, is not maintained, it may be subject to the potential hazards of corrosion and leakage.

Mt. Carmel Public Utility Co. encourages Customers to do the following:

1. All customer-owned piping should be periodically inspected for leaks or corrosion and repaired if any unsafe condition is discovered.
2. When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located in advance and the excavation done by hand. Call J.U.L.I.E. before you dig. The number is 811 or 1-(800) 892-0123
3. Plumbers and heating contractors can assist in locating, inspecting, and repairing the customers buried and/or atmospheric piping.
