





Environmental Disclosure Statement

For the 12 Months Ending June 30, 2015

The disclosure of this information is required under Section 16-127 of the Electric Service Customer Choice and Rate Relief Law of 1997 and the rules of the Illinois Commerce Commission, 83 Ill Admin. Code 421. Champion Energy is a member of the PJM & MISO regional transmission organizations that coordinates the movement of wholesale electricity in Illinois. Power plants can generate electricity from a number of different sources, which results in different emissions. The below reflects the PJM or MISO system average appropriate to the utility zone served.
