Dear Mr. Burk:

In Reference 1, the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) to The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company (PGL) as a result of a records audit conducted May 13-15 and May 27-28, 2014.

In Reference 2, PGL responded to the ICC stating it did not contest the NOA and requested an extension of the due date until October 31, 2014 in order to adopt the Integrys procedure on pressure testing. Reference 3 confirms that the ICC extended the due date.

In Reference 4, PGL provided its new procedure, Standard TEG 1030, to the ICC. Section 1030.1 of the procedure states the following:

The transition from Legacy procedures and equipment is to be completed within 60 days following the effective date of this standard.


Standard TEG 1030 was effective October 31, 2014.

To comply with all aspects of TEG 1030, pressure gauges with specific accuracy and minor increments are required. These gauges were ordered but delivery was delayed by the vendor. The new gauges will

not be available until after January 1, 2015. They will then be inspected by PGL and distributed for use. To allow time for this process, the transition period as described in Reference 4 has been extended to February 1, 2015.
