Dear Darin:

This letter is in response to the Notice of Amendment (NOA) issued on October 31, 2014, following an ICC Staff review of the Ameren Illinois (AIC) Operations and Maintenance Plan (O&M Plan) during Inspection # 2014-P-00426 on September 16-18, 2014.

As a result of the audit, Staff issued NOA # 2014-A001-00117, indicating that the AIC Gas Operations & Maintenance (O&M) Manual Plan does not give a definitive statement about when, how, or if electrofusion boxes will be calibrated. Staff requested that a process be identified in the O&M Plan for ensuring proper maintenance of the electrofusion boxes.

AIC previously responded on November 26, 2014 indicating that amended procedures would be provided to Staff by January 29, 2015.


In response to this Notice of Amendment, AIC will revise the Gas O&M Plan in the Electrofusion Procedure (Section POLY 2.05, subsection 1. General) to include the following statement:

**"Electrofusion processors shall be calibrated at intervals that at least meet the requirements contained in Manufacturer's Instructions. See POLY 4. There will be a compliance period of the manufacturer's recommended interval plus ninety (90) days. Beginning no later than January 2016, calibration records will be maintained in Maximo."**

These revisions will be included in the next update release of the AIC Gas O&M Plan in 2015.
