In Reference 1, the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) issued an Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) to The Peoples Gas Light and Coke Company (PGL) relating to Section 192.605 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

In Reference 2, PGL responded to the NOPV and committed to, in part, the following:

To address this issue, the following actions have or will be taken:

2. PGL will perform a DCVG survey over the pipe area to determine if settlement has caused the coating to dis-bond. This will be completed by June 1, 2015.

In Reference 3, PGL informed the ICC that due to unforeseen scheduling issue, the DCVG readings would be completed no later than July 31, 2015.
