Please note for AAR/DOT# 534349Y we have a crossing file containing ICC Order 83-0104 and X-resolution 9520. In 1983, the Kankakee County Road District claiming jurisdiction of the road filed a Petition seeking ICC designation of that crossing as "extra hazardous" and Grade Crossing Protection Fund assistance for Conrail to install automatic warning devices. The Illinois Grade Crossing Protection Fund paid \$66,785 of the \$70,300 total cost to install the signals. Unless the Road District handed over jurisdiction to their counterpart in Indiana, which is possible, it appears as though this has been an Illinois crossing for the purposes of ICC jurisdiction, whether or not the road is physically on one side of the border or the other. Did anyone verify with Kankakee Co. H.D. if there was a jurisdictional transfer to an Indiana highway agency?
