Tom, we abandoned the bridge over interstate I-74 and we (Jim Shircliff, CSXT property services) are selling the line of road and the bridge as shown on the attached maps to the ILDOT. Please let Mr. Black and the Mr. Stead know that we have not authorized anyone to perform work on the property located east of the abandonment area in Danville, IL, including Hillary yard. Vermillion Valley has approached CSXT about the possibility of leasing the line of road and the yard at Hillary, but no transactions have taken place. If they are working on our property, they are trespassing. We have not secured senior management approval for this transaction and we are having an internal meeting this Friday, 1/25, at 2:00 to discuss the transaction. Would you like to be included in the meeting? If so, I will set up a conference line, just let us know. Any information you could acquire as to the current situation would be helpful.
