We have a crossing which is a RR-Under in Thebes where ILL Rte 3 goes over the UP tracks as they approach the bridge at Thebes. Do you know if it has a US DOT#? I can only find an ICC internal temp number of 1680140. It was built in 1987 under ICC Order 87-0339 but I can't find where it was ever assigned a DOT number. Attached is a map and a location sketch.
