IN RE: VACATION OF DISTRICT ROADS

MEMORANDUM OF DECISION OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER

Greg Smothers, as Highway Commissioner of Unit Road District of Williamson County, Illinois, DO HERREBY CERTIFY that, I fixed February 24, 2012 at the hour of 10:00 a.m. at the Williamson County Highway Department office, as the time when and the place where I would examine the route of the road to be vacated, and hear reasons for or against the vacating of the same; that on February 9, 2012, I gave notice of the time and place of such examination and hearing by publication thereof in the **Southern Illinoisan**, a newspaper of general circulation in said district; and that I also gave at least 10 days' notice of the time and place of such examination and hearing to the County Superintendent of Highways of Williamson County, Illinois, by personal delivery of a written notice thereof; all within the time and in the manner required by law and all of which more fully appears from the copy of the said notice and certificate of the publication and delivery thereof, and by reference made a part of this memorandum.

I FURTHER CERTIFY that, pursuant to said notices of the hearing thereon, I was personally present on February 24, 2012, at the time and place and for the purposes stated in said notices, when and where I examined the route of the road to be vacated, as described in this document, met with all persons present and heard all reasons offered for or against the vacating of the same.

I FURTHER CERTIFY that, having examined the route of said road, and having heard all reasons offered for or against the vacation thereof, and having made the findings contained in this memorandum, I did then and there decide that I would vacate the road described therein, and did then and there publicly announce my decision.

I DO FIND that the vacation of the road described in said petition is in the public and economic interest, and I FURTHER FIND that all persons residing or owning land within two miles of any portion of the road proposed to be vacated shall and will still have reasonable access by way of a motor vehicle or other portable farm machinery commonly used in the area to farm land which said persons own or operate and to community and trade centers after said road is vacated.

IT IS ORDERED therefore, to vacate certain existing public district road which is described as follows:

A public road being located in Sections 1 and 12, Township 8 South, Range 3 East, and Sections 7 and 18, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, All of the 3rd principal meridian, Williamson County, Illinois, said centerline being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section 12, Township 8 South, Range 3 East; thence N 00'-24'-52" E, on said centerline 146.28 feet to the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 7, Township 8 South, Range 4 East; thence N 00'-31'-48" E, on said centerline, 2510.23 feet to the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section 12, Township 8 South, Range 3 East; thence N 00'-31'-48" E, on said centerline, 2692.11 feet to the South right of way line of a public road (TR 29) and the point of termination of the centerline described herein.

HEREBY IS GRANTED and that said road is to be vacated.




